

What we do with your personal information when you join Clonmel Credit Union

Welcome to Clonmel Credit Union, and thanks for becoming a member. We hope that you will really enjoy being part of our community and that you will stay with us for many years to come.



Why do we collect your information?

We need some information from you and your parents/quardians so as we can open an account for you, and you can start saving. Credit Unions have to comply with certain rules and regulations and these state that we have to collect your information if you have an account with us.



What information do we collect?

We need to collect information like your name, address, date of birth, savings information, signature, identification documents (passport, birth certificate). We also need these details from your parents/quardians.



What do we do with your information?

We only collect the information we need in order to help us do our job and provide you with an account and do things like:

- open an account for you
- make sure we comply with the law and the rules of the credit union
- get in touch with you and your parents/quardians when we need to



Will your information be shared with anyone?

From time to time we may need to share your information. If we do, this will only be with organisations that need to receive it, such as: regulators, the government, our IT people and other suppliers. But don't worry, all these people have to keep it safe and only use it for specific purposes.



How long will we keep your information?

We won't keep your information forever, just for as long as it is necessary and relevant. If you close your account, we will keep your information for 7 years after it has been closed.



What are your rights?

You and your parents have the right to:

Ask us to change information you think is wrong

Tells us you don't want your information to be processed

Ask us to remove information when it's not needed anymore

Ask to see the information we hold

Where we are processing your data based solely on your consent you have a right to withdraw that consent at any time and free of charge

Object to processing of your personal data where we are relying on a legitimate interest and there is something about you particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground.

Request that we a) provide you with a copy of any relevant personal data in a reusable format or b) request that we transfer your relevant personal data to another controller where it's technically feasible to do so.

Please note that the above rights don't always apply and there may be some limitations
